IN HONOR OF GUS SELLITTO AND EMIL PUSATERI

What: A bubble soccer themed fundraiser benefitting the American Cancer Society commemorating Gus Sellitto and Emil Pusateri

Where: Darcy Athletic Complex North Field

When: November 10th 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

How: Form a team of 8 people. Choose a team captain to be responsible for registration. Register your team by submitting a registration form to Dan Ryan, Brian Albertsen or Cole Pusateri. Teams will play for 20 minutes. The donation is \$160.00 per team (\$20.00 per person) for a 20 minute game.

Deadline: Registration forms must be in by **November 1st, 2018** along with donation of at least \$160.00 per team.

Mission: Kicking for the Cure was started in 2008, to raise money for cancer research in Honor of Gus Sellitto, who was diagnosed with a rare type of cancer known as Angiosarcoma. Sarcoma is a type of cancer that develops from certain tissues, like bone or muscle. They can be found in any part of the body. The Sellitto Family encouraged also Honoring Emil Pusateri, who was a beloved coach in the RVC Soccer Club, who passed away last year.

Emil Pusateri was diagnosed with Myeloma. Myeloma is a cancer of certain white blood cells called plasma cells. The cancerous plasma cells build up in the bone marrow. While scientists have made progress in understanding how certain changes in the DNA cause cancerous cells to develop, further research is needed to develop additional novel therapies, to learn how to best use them in combination, and to better understand how genomics (a patient's DNA) can be used to personalize therapy.
